REQUIREMENTS:

- Retired or sitting judicial officer, including temporary judges
- Computer or tablet device with video/audio
- Reliable high-speed internet connection

WHAT'S INVOLVED:

- Volunteers will review a packet containing the fictional case materials that are the subject of the mock trial, along with a volunteer packet that contains the presider's script, modified rules of evidence, competition rules and scoring criteria. Volunteers will preside over the virtual trials.
- A virtual orientation for volunteers will take place
 Thursday, January 21, 2021 at 12:00 pm. All volunteers are strongly encouraged to attend. A recording of the orientation will be available for those unable to attend.
- Check-in will open at 4:45 pm, all volunteers must be checked in by 5:00 pm. Most trials will end around 7:30 pm.

COMPETITION SCHEDULE:

Preliminary Rounds

Our greatest need for volunteers is during the preliminary rounds when all participating schools compete.

Approximately 18-19 judges are needed for each of the first four rounds.

Round 1 – Tuesday, February 2, 2021

Round 2 - Thursday, February 4, 2021

Round 3 – Tuesday, February 9, 2021

Round 4 – Thursday, February 11, 2021

*Round 5 – Tuesday, February 16, 2021

*Round 6 - Thursday, February 18, 2021

*To be eligible to volunteer during the playoff rounds, judges should volunteer in at least two of the first four rounds. CRF-OC strives to accommodate all date preferences, but availability for the playoff rounds is limited. Priority will be given to earliest requests.
