Peer Court is an innovative juvenile program that provides students, ages 14-18, the opportunity to sit on a jury and recommend sanctions for actual first-time, non-violent juvenile offenders. A Superior Court judge will preside over the sessions and select students from the audience to serve as jurors.

Student jurors question the juvenile and their guardian(s) about the offense, then deliberate with the assistance of an attorney adviser and decide upon appropriate sanctions to recommend to the judge.
