



## MOOT COURT

*CRF-OC's Middle School Moot Court is designed as an oral advocacy program similar to the format of speech and debate. Students will be given a hypothetical case to analyze. Using a closed library of relevant cases, students will present an argument as to why the court should resolve the issue in their favor.*

#### How it Works

- Schools will have time prepare and practice before conducting their own internal competition. The top performing pair from each school will be eligible to compete in CRF-OC's virtual one-day countywide competition on **April 29, 2021**.
- The case materials will be released to registered schools **January 2021**. Outside research is not required. CRF-OC will provide teachers with all of the materials needed in order to participate.
- Program is open to Orange County middle school students in the **7th and 8th grades**.
- Registration fee is \$100 per school
